

Green Leaf Cafe WiFi Hotspot Instructions



Thanks for stopping by the Green Leaf Cafe. We hope you enjoy yourself here.

We are experimenting with providing limited WiFi Internet access to Green Leaf Cafe customers using 802.11b wireless-enabled portable computers or personal digital assistants (PDAs). You will be able to register for access directly from your 802.11b enabled laptop or PDA.

Use of the WiFi Hotspot also requires agreeing to and following the Terms of Service and Acceptable Use Policy found on the WiFi Zone Login screen.

Technical support is not available for this free service, however, you may e-mail questions or problem reports to "hotspot@greenleaf.com".

Service Requirements

- Portable computer or PDA with an 802.11b compatible wireless network card
- Software to support the wireless network card
- Web browser software

Getting Connected

Complete the following steps to get connected:

1. Configure your computer or PDA's TCP/IP network settings to use DHCP. With **DHCP enabled**, your computer is automatically assigned an IP address when you connect to our network **This is the default setting on most devices.**
2. Ensure that your wireless network card is enabled and supports a connection using the **802.11b** wireless protocol. **View the list of available wireless networks** detected by your computer's wireless network card and **connect to the "Green_Leaf" wireless network.** In some rare instances, you may also need to configure your SSID to Green_Leaf; disable WEP/WPA encryption; and set the connection to Infrastructure or Access Point mode.
3. Start your web browser. You will be able to register for free wireless Internet access directly from your web browser.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: I have failed to validate my account in x minutes.

A: You have been given an amount of minutes of temporary Internet access in order to retrieve the email we sent to you and validate your free account. What you can do now is either create a new account and then validate it properly, or get on the Internet from somewhere else and validate the account you just created. If you need us to resend you the validation email, there is a link provided on the login screen.

Q: What steps are required in order to create and validate a new account?

A: Here is an overview of the steps:

- Pick a username, enter your email address, and enter the password you would like. An email will be sent to you with a link you can click to validate your account.
- Once the account is created, you need Internet access in order to check your email and click the validation link. In order to get temporary access to the Internet during your validation period, visit any URL (for example www.google.com) to get the login page again.
- Enter your login information. You will be given several minutes of temporary Internet access, plenty of time to check your email and click on the link.
- Once that last step is done, you will have activated your free Internet access!
